Mandatory steps in the application process

Personal contact information

Canada

- Level of study
- CV template
- Program of study
- Proof of marks, transcripts
- Tell us about yourself
- References
- Letter of introduction and proof of indigenous ancestry (only if you are applying for a TD Aboriginal Nursing Fund award)
- Select the awards you are applying for
- Pay the single \$35 application fee



Optional steps in the application process

You will be able to refer to education/work/volunteer items that are not directly related to your studies, but that might complement them.

For example, if you are planning to specialize in hospice and palliative care, and have education in music or art therapy that you plan to use in that role, this would be helpful information.



Ready? Let's start working!

Start early and give yourself plenty of time! The online process is lengthy – just picture yourself with a prestigious award to add to your resumé, and a welcome cheque to help cover your study expenses.



Make yourself a timetable

The deadline is February 20th - starting your application on February 19th just isn't going to work for you!

Week 1 Check your eligibility; complete the basic forms that require no special effort; request your references
Week 2 Organize your GPAs and transcripts, and work on your resumé, using the online template
Week 3 Complete your Tell Us About Yourself information; check that your references are underway, and follow up if needed.

Week 4 You should have everything under control, and be able to submit your application!



References

- Give your referees plenty of notice when asking them to complete a reference.
- Make sure they know that their references must show as Complete before you can submit your application
- The references must be completed in the language of the application
- It is your responsibility to follow up with your referees if necessary



Proof of marks

- Required a signed, PDF format statement of marks on university letterhead from your educational institution
- As well uploaded legible official transcripts, or webbased marks if the transcripts are not legible





Please include

- Cumulative average over the year for baccalaureate candidates
- Undergraduate GPA plus current marks for graduate candidates
- Graduate GPA plus current marks for post-graduate candidates

If you are applying for a TD Aboriginal Nursing Fund award (1)

You must include a **letter of introduction** from a respected member of your community. It should speak to your community involvement, and your capacity to act as a positive role model.

The letter need not include recommendations of your nursing abilities, unless the person providing it has specific knowledge.



If you are applying for a TD Aboriginal Nursing Fund award (2)

You also need to provide proof of your indigenous ancestry.

Options include

- First Nations the Treaty number to prove status
- Non-status birth certificate and family proof of status
- Inuit Nunavut number
- Métis Métis number
